



#### **Tittabawassee River Floodplain Restoration**




- 490 acres with nature trails and habitat restoration

- Opened June 28th!






# Sygo, Hoppler Creek, Redtail Nature Preserves


- 1,460 acres featuring wetlands, nature trails (Sygo and Redtail)
